> North Macedonia is a landlocked country bordering with Kosovo to the northwest, Serbia to the north, Bulgaria to the east, Greece to the south, and Albania to the west.

- > Skopje is located in the north part of Macedonia and it is our capital city.
- > Skopje is the largest city in Macedonia and it is the country's political, cultural, economic, and academic center.

Ohrid is a city in Macedonia, the seat of Ohrid Municipality. It is the largest city on Lake Ohrid, Ohrid once had 303 Churches, one for each day of the year, and has been referred to as a "Jerusalem (of the Balkans)".

KOKINO

- > Kokino is the oldest archaeological site in North Macedonia that finds date from about the 19th century BC, corresponding to the early European Bronze Age. It shows signs of occupation for the period from the 19th to the 7th centuries BC.
- > It was discovered by archeologist Jevica Stankovsk, director of the national museum in Rumanova in 2001.

Canyon Matka

Matka is a canyon located west of central Skopje, North Macedonia. It is one of the most popular outdoor destinations in North Macedonia and is home to several medieval monasteries. The Matka Lake within the Matka Canyon is the oldest artificial lake in the country.

There are ten caves of Matka Canyon, with the shortest in length being 20 meters and the longest being 176 meters.

Due in large part to its proximity to Skopje, Matka Canyon is a popular destination for citizens and tourists.

Rapelling on the Treska River is a popular activity, as are fishing, hunting, and swimming.

Samuil's fortress

Samuil's fortress is a fortress in the old town of Ohrid, North Macedonia. It was the capital during the rule of king Samuil of Macedonia at the turn of the 11th century.

According to recent excavations by Macedonian archaeologists, it was contended that this fortress was built on the place of an earlier fortification, dated to the 4th century BC, which was probably built by King Philip II of Macedon.

Today, this historical monument is a major tourist attraction and was heavily restored in 2005 with the addition of entirely new battlements where none had survived.

The Macedonian flag (i.e. The flag of Vergina)

The flag of North Macedonia is the national flag of North Macedonia and depicts a stylized yellow sun on a red field, with eight broadening rays extending from the center to the edge of the field. It was created by Miroslav Grčev and was adopted on 5 October 1995.

The new eight-rayed sun represents the "new sun of Liberty" referred to in "Dones nad Makedonija", the national anthem of North Macedonia.



The first flag of the country, known as the Vergina Flag, featured the Vergina Sun, a symbol that had been discovered at Aigai, the first capital and burial ground of the ancient kings of Macedonia.

Today it can be said that the Vergina flag is one of the most significant symbols that unifies both the culture and the history.

The Macedonian currency

- > The Macedonian denar is the currency of North Macedonia.
- > The name denar comes from the name of the ancient Roman monetary unit, the denarius. The currency symbol is ден, the first three letters of its name.

Macedonian is also a recognized minority language in parts of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Romania, Albania and Serbia and it is spoken by emigrant communities predominantly in Australia, Canada and the United States.

Linguists distinguish 29 dialects of Macedonian, with linguistic differences separating Western and Eastern groups of dialects. It is written using an adapted 21-letter version of the Cyrillic script with six original letters.

Macedonian is an Eastern South Slavic language. Spoken as a first language by around two million people, it serves as the official language of North Macedonia. Most speakers can be found in the country and its diaspora, with a smaller number of speakers throughout the transnational region of Macedonia.

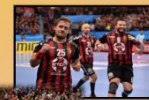
Macedonian sport

Macedonians have appreciated sports all throughout their long history. As with most European countries, North Macedonia has football as its top sport. Goran Pandev is widely considered the star player of the team.



Basketball is also very popular and their national basketball team became part of FIBA in 1983.

Another popular sport in Macedonia is handball. Their women's team, Kometal Skopje, took the EHF Women's Champions League European Cup in 2002.



When it comes to the Olympics, Macedonia's first medal came in 1956 when Skopje-born Blažica Vidmic played for then Yugoslavia as a goalkeeper and took the silver.

During the summertime, the Ohrid Swimming Marathon is held on Lake Ohrid which most of the country's best swimmers participate.
