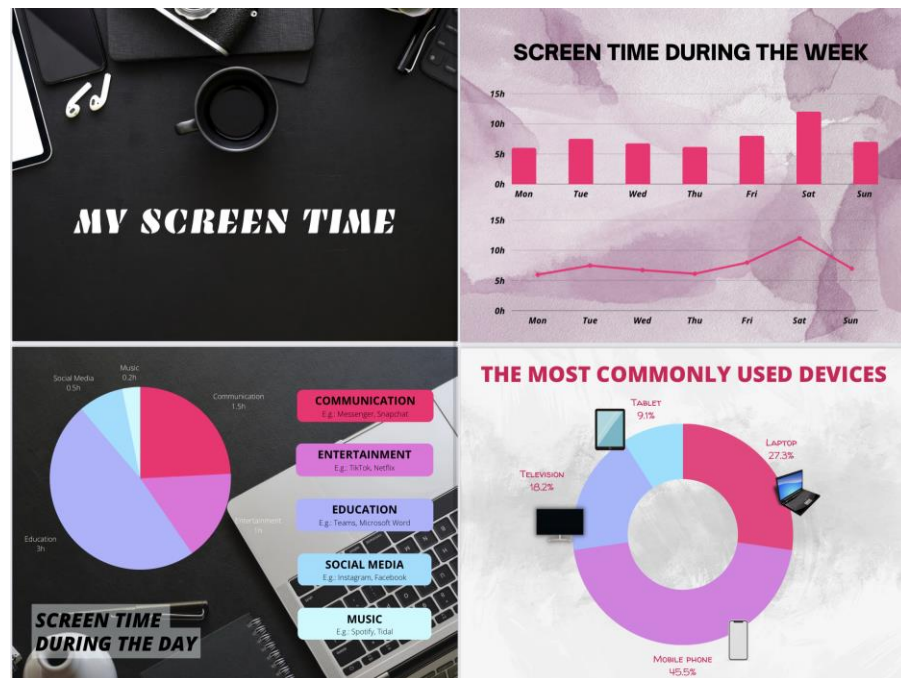

BURSA - TURKEY

GRAND MOSQUE OF BURSA

Ulu Cami Mosque, built in the years 1396-1400 by order of Sultan Bayezid I, the fourth sultan of the Ottoman Empire. It is the largest temple in Bursa and towers over the city like a fortress.

The mosque is built of yellow limestone that comes from the Uludağ Mountains and has two tall minarets. The mosque was built in the style of the era, so a large stone building in a rectangular or square pattern with many small domes. In the middle of the building, 20 domes were erected.

Legend has it that after defeating the Hungarian king, the sultan promised to build 20 mosques, but his advisor, for economic reasons, proposed building one mosque with 20 domes.

BURSA ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

Among the collection of objects, you can find very rare finds discovered in the areas of Musiya and Bitkhis, dating back to the 3rd millennium BC, up to the Byzantine era.

In the main hall of the archaeological museum, there are: stone and bronze axes, objects made of clay, containers, bronze vessels and other items. The museum has brought out works of ancient art - figurines of various shapes, vessels of various techniques, ornaments.

The archaeological finds discovered in the villages of Karachubaya and Shukraniye, from where a Greek-Persian tombstone were brought, can be considered the most noteworthy and interesting among the Museum's collections.

BASIC INFORMATION

- A city in northwestern Turkey, in the ancient land of Bithynia. Located 25 km from the coast of the Sea of Marmara, at the foot of Mount Uludağ, formerly known as Mount Olympus. The first capital of the Ottoman Empire, currently the fourth largest city in Turkey. In 2014, Bursa was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- The city is an important center of trade, industry and culture. Traditionally known for their clothing products. Today, the car and machine, chemical, footwear and food industries are also well-developed here. The seat of the Uludağ University, museums (including the Archaeological Museum), and a tourist center: winter sports are practiced on the slopes of Uludağ Mountain, and the districts with sulfur and iron springs have the status of a spa.

COVERED BAZAAR

Near the Grand Mosque there is a real Turkish bazaar, which is not as crowded with tourists as the Grand Bazaar in Istanbul, which makes its atmosphere more real.

In the bazaar, there is a trade in materials and textiles, with silk leading here, and everything is located in the former Koza Han caravanserai from 1491, where there are two floors with 95 rooms and a square courtyard in the middle, where there are now restaurants. Additionally, there is a small mosque in the middle.

GREEN MOSQUE

The mosque was built between 1419 and 1424 by order of Sultan Mehmed I. The name Green Mosque comes from the blue-green tiled interior decorations, which was recently inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List.

At the entrance to the mosque there is a vestibule that leads up the stairs to the central prayer room. The main hall in the central corridor has an octagonal white marble fountain with a swimming pool which is located under the tallest dome of the Green Mosque.

The mosque is still a place of prayer, so during the tour you need to show respect for the people praying and do not disturb. Visiting the mosque is free.

HISAR

Also called the Citadel, surrounded by walls, which were fortified after the conquest of Bursa by the second Sultan of the Ottoman Empire, Orhan. The Sultan also built a wooden palace here. In a park with a beautiful view of the city, a 19th-century clock tower and two tombs were erected, where Sultan Orhan and his son Orhan are buried. It is a very important place for Turks as the first and second Sultans of the Ottoman Empire are buried here.
