In total, I spent about 140 hours online, which gives the average of 37,5 hours per week 4,84 per day.

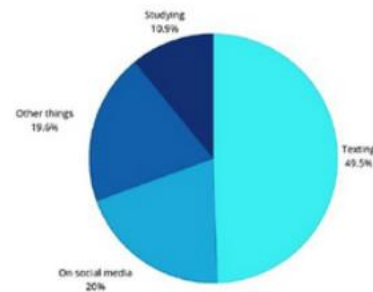
I hardly ever use computer I use my phone for nearly everything so I did not use my computer. All 140 hours I spent was on my Phone.

I SPENT MY TIME...



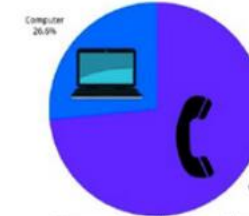

This month was my birthday so generally I did what makes me happy. I chatted with my friends whom are far away from me, I went some places that I wanted to visit so this may be my favourite of all months.

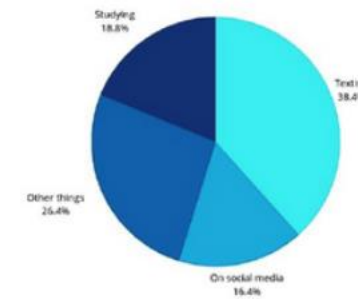
In total, it seems that I spent 120 hours. In a week, I spent 40 hours which means 3 hours per day.

In september I was on my phone each day. There were questions that my teachers send me for me to solve them. And also I found an application that is really interesting which is an app has conferences,named TED.

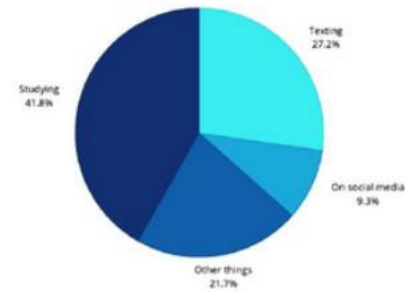
I listened so many confrences from that app maybe that can be the reason my screentime is really long this time.

I SPENT MY TIME...



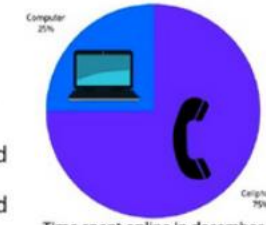

I went to some places from out of the city and I used my phone to take pictures of flowers,shops,places,animals,my friends and me.

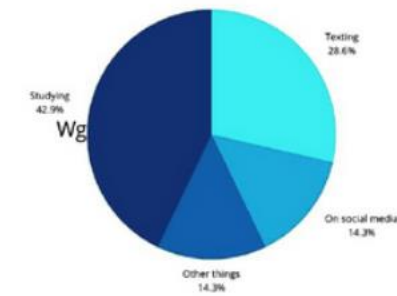
AlsoI used my phone to edit the pictures and share them.

In January, the semester holiday started on 23 January. Before that the teachers gave us assignments that should be finished by the time we come back to school.

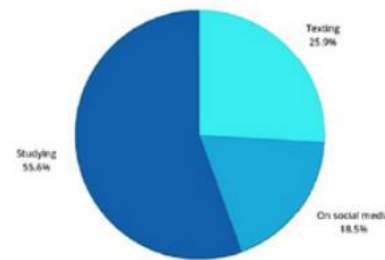

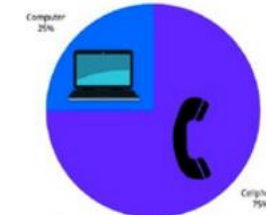

FEBRUARY

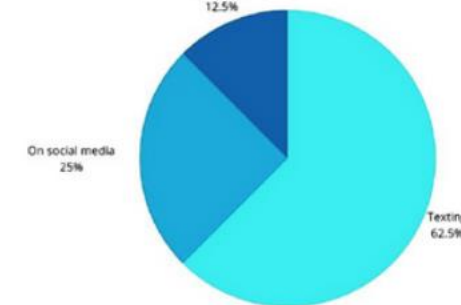

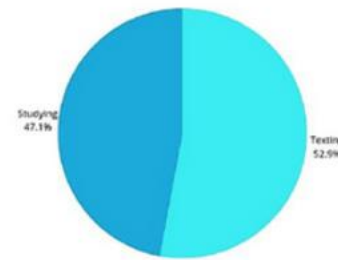
MARCH

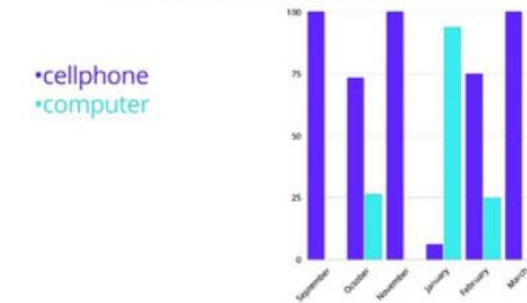

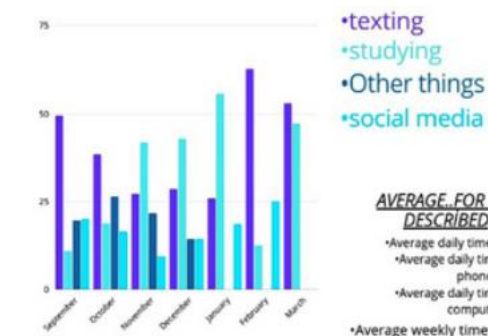
